This compact exhibition celebrates the 150th anniversary of the first hospital to be established in Middlesbrough which opened its doors on the 7th March 1859.

It tells the story of how, following a dramatic accident at a local works, the first Cottage Hospital in England was opened in the town by Sister Mary of Coatham.

The exhibition follows the move to the North Ormesby site and subsequent expansion.
