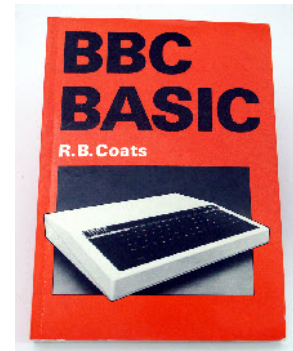
DORMAN MUSEUM

This exhibition traces the origins of electronic gaming from the earliest TV 'Pong' machines up to the present day.

The story of electronic gaming is told using actual examples of hardware and software dating back to the 1970's. The exhibition also showcases the growth of a well known British games developers - the Oliver twins; how a modern concept character is developed; and what sort of jobs are available within the industry.

Visitors have the chance to try out a number of actual vintage machines that will bring the memories flooding back for the 'older' generation of gamers.
